Joanne Bath will be giving the parent talks. Joanne is a registered Teacher Trainer of the Suzuki Association of the Americas and is the Hardy Distinguished Professor of Suzuki Pedagogy at the School of Music at East Carolina University. Joanne was the first Suzuki teacher in North Carolina and one of the first in the United States. She has taught Suzuki violin in Greenville for 45 years, teaching all ages and levels from 3 year olds to adults, with 80 private students a week for 20 of the years. Joanne and Charles are the parents of 4 grown children, all of whom studied violin with their mother. Joanne regularly speaks about the Suzuki Approach throughout the country and world including Sweden, England, Australia, and Italy.
